

Stoneygate fly through video text transcript

Satellite view of the North West shows Preston, Manchester and Liverpool labelled. This then zooms in close to Preston and stays over Stoneygate, with the caption 'Stoneygate: A New Urban Village'. The Stoneygate area is shown by a digital interpretation of what it will look like, using neutral colours and the surrounding area outside of Stoneygate turns to black and white.

The black and white area fades away and the colour version turns into a 3D digital model. The camera zooms in on this to show a simplified digital interpretation of Church Street from the view of a pedestrian. This then transitions to a digital sketch of the area, showing new and modern buildings and a seating area with bunting between two new buildings.

The video returns to the 3D digital model and shows where Church Street meets Manchester Road. This then switches to a digital sketch showing trees and new shops and buildings.

The 3D digital model then comes back, pans over Stoneygate and shows Cardinal Newman College Onward Homes. The camera then moves through to model to Horrocks Quarter towards Cotton Court. A digital sketch now shows two three storey flats and a tree-lined walkway between them both.

The 3D digital model then returns and moves down Queen Street to show where the new Stoneygate Square will be. A digital sketch then shows how this will look, showing a square with cafes and people, surrounded by tall buildings and flats.

The 3D digital model then moves to round the corner where another digital sketch shows markets, seating areas and new houses and buildings alongside current ones in Stoneygate.
